Have you ever imagined what it's like to be on the run, looking over your shoulder, wondering if you have been spotted, afraid to go certain places or jumping at the sound of a car, doorbell or phone? That's the place we meet most of the women who come to us for help. They have just escaped a violent relationship after hearing threats of being hunted down, never being able to hide and if found seriously hurt or killed.

When Kimberly came to us with her children, she exhibited all the signs of fear and lack of hope we see too often. She had lived on the edge for so long that she had a hard time transitioning from her hyper-vigilant state. It's hard to make good decisions and problem solve in that kind of survival mode. After we helped her to relocate with her children, she told us that the pain that she had experienced was becoming a memory.

On your behalf we are privileged to help heroic women like Kimberly begin to come out of the shadows into the light of a new life. To begin to dream and plan for a life that they had imagined for themselves and their children.

Right now is the time to catch our breath and take another deep breath in anticipation of the upcoming holidays and year end rush that happens to us (and you?) each year. Summer and fall were a blur with construction, maintenance at our facilities, as well as the ongoing receiving, stabilizing and moving the many families who came to us in need. We have seen many precious lives renewed which is truly our bottom line.

It is always good as Thanksgiving approaches to remember the blessings that we have experienced this year. Suffice it to say, we are <u>so</u> very grateful for your generosity and support. Your gifts of \$241.00 in September & \$208.00 in October of 2023 will play a crucial role in our very specific ministry of reaching out to those domestic violence victims and their children whose very lives are in danger.
