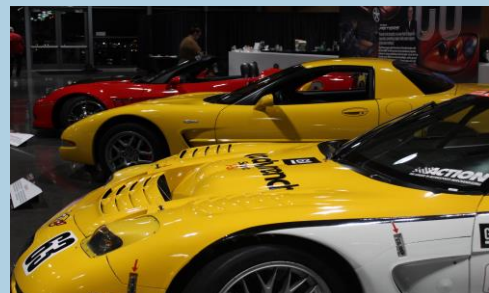

We took the opportunity to attend the Ron Fellows C8 Stingray Owners class this last February, and I don't know about Cheri but, I had a blast!

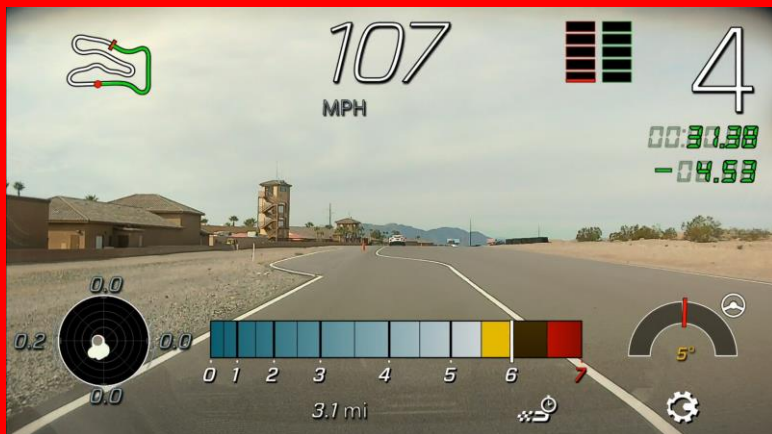
If you own a C8 and haven't taken the school, I highly recommend doing it. If you DON'T own a C8, I highly recommend taking the school! They also hold schools for C8 Z06, Cadillac Blackwing cars (ATSv and CTSv), and Radical.

I thought I knew a lot about the C8. Well, I did, but I learned even more about the car that I would NEVER do in my own. Sure, I might autocross at some point. I don't know that I would track my car now, but now I know HOW to if I ever wanted to.

I learned the C8 Z51 car is much more capable than the C7 Z51. Try trying to turn and brake in a C7. Not going to happen. In the C8, that's how you balance the car and get it to dive into a corner a lot harder than you would be able to do with a C7!

Lots of fun, lots of track time, a lot of mental focus.

Overall, I would highly recommend doing this if you get the chance.
