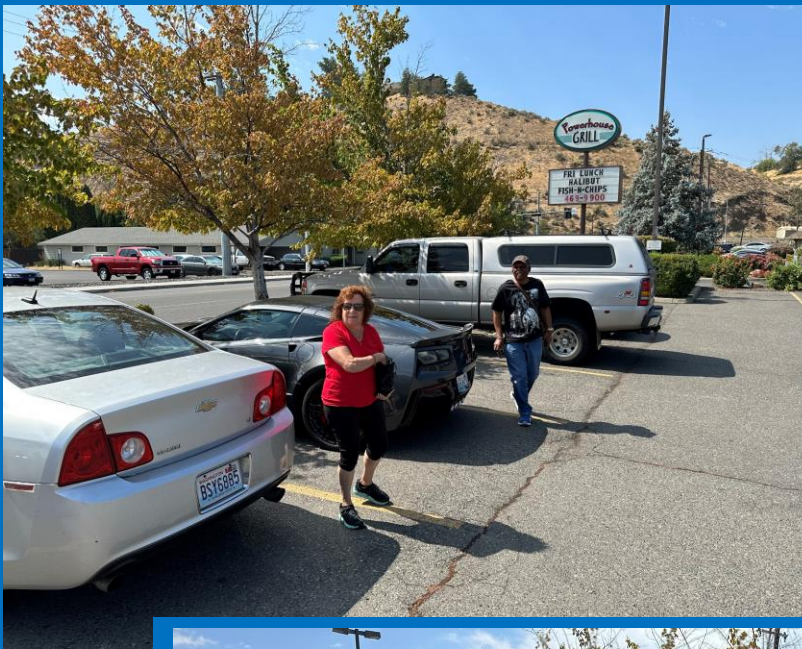

# Become a Sponsor
